A Chara,

I would like to propose that the Old Milford Electoral Area would be returned as an Area in your new Boundary Changes for the Donegal Area. At Present we have 37 Co Councillors in Donegal. I believe that the present Areas of Inishowen and Letterkenny are too large and are unrepresentable. I think Inishowen could be ~~split~~ split to a 7 Seated to include North Inishowen and Bunrana to Bridgend. The Letterkenny Area could include Newtowncunningham, Manacunningham, Drumkeen, Conroy and Letterkenny Town and would be a 7 Seated. The Donegal and Stranorlar could remain as they are at present. However the original Milford Area as it was for a large number of Years could include the Fard Peninsula, Rattinulla, Ramelton, Rosquill, Creeslough, Dunfanaghy, Termon, Glenswilly, Kilmacrossnan, and Take from the Letterkenny Area the Booths of Illistain, Ednacarnan and Woodlands and would become a 5 Seated. The Present Glenties Area would lose Dunfanaghy and Creeslough and could return to a 5 Seated. The People of Dunfanaghy and Creeslough are more of a kin looking towards Letterkenny than looking towards the Gaeltacht Areas of Cloughaneely, Gweedore and the Rosses. Just a few observations for your consideration. I don't want to go in too serious a deliberation at this conjuncture. Thanks.
