Dear Sir / Madam

I would like to ask you to increase the representation of Comeragh Municipal District in Co Waterford. While we have a large land mass in the centre of the county straddling both sides of the Comeragh mountains we have only 6 public representatives. While I acknowledge that we would have a favourable ratio in relation to some constituencies, I and we as a group of councillors feel that we are hampered in the county when up against a neighbouring 8 person body on the west and an 18 person body on the east. We feel that financially as a council we are feeling the pinch in the draw down of funding. Furthermore we do not have a large town within our base and no revenue stream. I believe that if we were to expand both east and west at the expense of the other two, we would be on a more even keel.

Our position is further emphasised by the fact that in plenary we feel that there is a heavy urban bias of 18-14 in deliberations.

I would suggest perhaps an increase to 7/8 elected members at the expense of the metropolitan and perhaps a constituency split between the metropolitan and the county on a fairer division. I hope this notion will be entertained as irrespective as to whether I stand or not at the next election, it is the constituents of Comeragh who will benefit and no particular individual.
