

- 3) Both of the above together would require an 8-seater, again outside the 5-7 seat remit. Firhouse and Rathfarnham areas can't go together this time without one or the other being split.
- 4) Terenure and Templeogue are too small for a LEA in their own right but could be united fully or partially with Rathfarnham to form an LEA at the outer edge of the average. Rathfarnham and Templeogue and Terenure together = \$3,249 divided by 7 equals 7,607 per rep, 59 short of the max allowable per Councillor. However moving Terenure in with Tallaght Central places it 250 above the minimum.

⁵⁾ ALL Tallaght areas, including Ballinascorney and Clondalkin Ballymount add up to 79,087 = 11 seats or 7,189 per Cllr. If Tallaght gets 11 seats between two divisions and DMW already has 17 seats = 28 seats gone, this means there are 12 remaining. It is not possible to divide the remainder into two six seaters or a S and 7 seater without splitting historical neighbourhoods in two and designing areas in a very haphazard way. It makes more sense to create a core 6-seat Tallaght LEA and allow the areas bordering the Belgard Road to go in with Terenure to make a 5-seat LEA. A small number of adjoining Tallaght DED areas to Firhouse would make the last S-seat LEA.
