Please find set out below my submission to the Local Electoral Area Boundary Committee.

Context

The basis for this submission is to ensure that there is a more even spread of county councillors across the county of Mayo, in addition to ensuring that there is a distinct town based focus to each Municipal District.

This submission addresses the existing large, unwieldy Municipal Districts that exist in Co. Mayo, that have long been a cause of concern and focus for criticism in the county. In achieving this, it has been necessary to create Local Electoral Areas (LEAs) consisting of 3 and 4 councillors.

Although suggested to be used in exceptional circumstances, a county such as Mayo with sparse population settlements requires this exception to be used. This, it is proposed, will ensure that there is a fairer geographic placement of councillors.

Finally, this submission represents a sincere effort to ensure that the proposed areas created form a distinct geographic area, with common interest across its population.

With a population of 12575, this would be a 3-seater LEA. It consists of the Erris area, a distinct, which due to population decline is no longer able to support a 3-seat area in its own right. Therefore, territory has to be added to it. There is a logical link between Erris and Crossmolina; this town was linked to the former ESB electricity station in Bellacorick for many years. In addition, the main infrastructure routes into Erris (namely the N59 and R312 roads) pass through or near Crossmolina. Therefore, there is much common cause between Crossmolina and Erris. A further reason to link these two places, is that Crossmolina and its hinterland has enough population to counterbalance the Erris area, resulting that there is likely to be sufficient population in the Crossmolina area to secure representation for its population.

Potential Municipal Districts

If the above listed electoral areas were considered to be too small to exist as stand alone Municipal Districts, 2 or more of them could be joined to form a single Municipal District (consisting of two distinct and separate LEAs). This would ensure efficiency of service delivery, with the safeguard that distinct areas within the county would have political representation.

Potential linked Municipal Districts could be formed by joining Belmullet and Ballina (to form a North Mayo Municipal District), or by joining Claremorris and Swinford (to form an East Mayo Municipal District). Ballinrobe could be linked to Castlebar, or indeed Westport and Castlebar could be linked. Another option could include forming Castlebar as a stand alone county town Municipal District.
