I am making a submission to the boundary review for Council elections.

I represent the Greystones, Delgany, Kilcoole, Newcastle and Kiladreenan area. Apart from Kiladreenan, which is really part of Newtown Mt Kennedy the area is cohesive. The half hourly bus service connects Newcastle and Kilcoole to Greystones and Dublin and the

Communities are interlinked. It has been suggested that the proposed changes would separate Greystones/Delgany from Kilcoole which might be linked to Enniskerry and Kilmacanoge. However Kilcoole/Newcastle has no connection with the latter as there is no bus and both look towards Bray.

In my view the area should remain the same with the possible exception of Kiladreenan.
